Ride For Your Life

A ride to Congress in memory of Sarah (Debbink) Langenkamp

On 19 November, cyclists from around the region and across the country will be gathering in memory of Sarah Langenkamp, who was tragically killed early this year on River Road in Maryland. Sarah was a mother and Foreign Service officer who willingly accepted risks serving the country overseas, only to succumb to a distracted truck driver after dropping her son off at school. Federal statics show the number of cycling deaths in the US rose 44% from 2010 - 2022. Every RBC member knows the risks of the sport we love, and this is an opportunity to add to voices asking for a change in policy to save lives. In the event you are not able to attend, please seek opportunities to speak to your local, State, and Federal representatives about the need to improve safety for all road users.
